I invite your attention to the reference cited.

In the reference cited the Hon'ble High Court of Madras directed that, whenever new vehicles were sold after 01.09.2021, it is mandatory for coverage of bumper to bumper insurance every year, in addition to covering the driver, passengers and owner of the vehicle, for a period of five years.

All the Registering Authorities and Assistant Registering Authorities are instructed that the above High Court order has to be strictly followed without any deviation.

Necessary instructions should be issued to all the Insurance companies and all dealers in your jurisdiction. At the time of the registration all the Motor Vehicles Inspectors should verify the Insurance Certificate for the compliance of the High Court order without any deviation.
