Answer: Sub-section (1F) of the section 206c of the Act provides for TCS as the rate of 1% on sale of motor vehicle of value exceeding 10 lakh rupees. This is irrespective of the mode of payment

* Tax collected at source

Thus if the value of motor vehicle is 20 lakh rupees, out of which 5 lakh rupees has been paid in cash and balance amount by way of cheque, the tax shall be collected at source at the rate of 1% on total sale consideration of 20 lakh rupees only under sub-section (1F) of section 206 C of the Act.

As per CBDT circular dated 24th June 2016 :- whenever sale of goods / services in cash exceeds Rs.2 Lakhs, only Cash sale consideration will attract TCS @1%.

Example goods worth Rs.5 Lakhs is sold to customer for which Rs.3 Lakhs is received in cash and balance in cheque, then TCS @1% needs to be collected on only on Rs.3 Lakhs (only on Cash Receipt)
