

LOCK DOWN CARE

Tips and tricks to keep your Jeep vehicle in top shape while not in use.

DO'S



While performing the vehicle check, use masks and sanitizer for protection.

Protect the vehicle with a car cover if it's parked in an open area or uncovered parking.



Inspect if the brake fluid, coolant and engine oil are at an optimum level and ensure that the engine bay is free of debris.

Turn the engine on once every 2 to 3 days for the diesel variant and every alternate day for the petrol variant. Maintain the engine idling at 2000rpm for 5 minutes to recharge the battery.

DO'S



Brake pads may bind with the brake discs due to atmospheric humidity. Drive the vehicle back and forth a few meters to remove oxidation marks from the brake discs.

Use a microfiber cloth or chamois leather with a mild detergent to clean the vehicle. If any bird droppings are found, wash them off immediately to prevent acidic spot formation.



Ensure all windows are rolled up, doors are locked, lights and electrical accessories are switched off, and electronic parking brake is applied, before leaving the vehicle.

DON'TS



Do not park near a garbage bin, wastewater channels or in waterlogged areas.

Do not leave any edibles or personal belongings inside the vehicle.



To prevent scratching, do not pull the body cover while unwrapping the vehicle.
