-COPY OF-NOTIFICATION <u>Dated 31st August, 2015</u> (Published in the Gazette of India on 2nd September, 2015)

The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which the Central Government proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 110 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules shall be taken into consideration after expiry of thirty days from the date on which the copies of this notification as published in the Gazette of India are made available to the Public.

- 2. Objections or suggestions, if any, may be sent to the Joint Secretary (Transport), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Transport Bhawan, Parliament Street, New Delhi-110001.
- 3. Any objections or suggestions which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft rules before the expiry of the period aforesaid shall be considered by the Central Government.

Draft rules

- 1. These rules may be called as the Central Motor Vehicles (Fourteenth Amendment) Rules, 2015.
- 2. In the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989, (hereinafter referred as the said rules), in rule 96, after subrule (4), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-
 - "(4 A). notwithstanding anything contained in clause (i) of sub-rule (4),-
 - (a) New vehicle models of category L2 exceeding 125cc manufactured on and after the 1st April, 2017 shall be fitted with anti-lock braking system conforming to IS: 14664: 2010;
 - (b) Existing vehicle models of category L2 exceeding 125cc manufactured on and after the 1st April, 2018 shall be fitted with anti-lock braking system conforming to IS: 14664:2010;
 - (c) New vehicle models of category L2 not exceeding 125cc manufactured on and after the 1st April, 2017 shall be fitted with combined braking system conforming to IS: 14664: 2010; and
 - (d) Existing vehicle models of category L2 not exceeding 125cc manufactured on and after the 1st April, 2018 shall be fitted with combined braking system conforming to IS: 14664: 2010.".
