Car rams streetlight as driver loses control

Ahmedabad: A speeding Toyota Qualis rammed a streetlight on CTM Road near Ahmedabad-Vadodara expressway on Tuesday morning. The impact was such that the car's roof was crushed and badly damaged.

However, all the occupants are believed to be safe as they fled the scene soon after the incident, leaving the car behind. Ramol police station officials believe that the vehicle was occupied by highway diesel thieves.

Police officials said that they received information about the accident but when they reached on the spot around 11 am, there was no present near the spot. The police found four empty plastic carboys along with pipes which are usually used to extract diesel from petrol or diesel tank.

"We believe that the car was coming from the opposite direction and when the driver got distracted for a while, he lost his control and rammed the pillar. They must fled the spot before their identity was revealed. We have found concrete proof about who they were. We are working on the leads at the moment," said KJ Gohil, inspector of Ramol police station.
