	1. Head northwest on Vittal Mallya Rd	go 49 m total 49 m
	2. Take the 1st left onto Kasturba Rd/Rajaram Mohan Roy Rd/Vittal Mallya Rd Pass by Sree Kanteerava Stadium (on the right)	go 550 m total 600 m
	3. Turn right onto Kasturba Rd/Rajaram Mohan Roy Rd	go 47 m total 650 m
	4. Take the 1st right onto Rajaram Mohan Roy Rd Pass by Sree Kanteerava Stadium (on the right)	go 700 m total 1.4 km
	5. At Corporation/Hudson Cir , take the 1st exit onto Bangalore - Mysore Rd/Kasturba Rd Continue to follow Bangalore - Mysore Rd Pass by Ramsons Granites (on the left in 6.4 km)	go 7.3 km total 8.7 km
	6. Turn left onto ORR Pass by TOTAL petrol bunk (on the left)	go 850 m total 9.5 km
	7. Take the ramp onto NICE Bangalore Mysore Expressway	go 8.6 km total 18.1 km
	8. Take the exit onto NICE Ring Rd Toll road	go 4.1 km total 22.2 km
	9. Take the exit toward Kanakapura Rd Toll road	go 450 m total 22.6 km
	10. Turn right onto Kanakapura Rd Pass by Karnataka State Sericulture Research&Development Institute (on the left in 800 m)	go 38.8 km total 61.4 km
	11. Continue straight onto NH 209/SH 3 Continue to follow NH 209	go 46.9 km total 108 km
	12. Turn left to stay on NH 209 Pass by Mahadeshwara Temple (on the left in 12.7 km)	go 33.9 km total 142 km
	13. Turn left onto NH 209/SH 79 Continue to follow SH 79 Pass by R C M Higher Primary School (on the left in 500 m)	go 5.7 km total 148 km
	14. Slight right onto Kollegal-Hasanurghat Rd Pass by Jetavana (on the left in 9.1 km)	go 47.3 km total 195 km
	15. Continue onto SH38	go 5.8 km total 201 km
	16. Turn left	go 1.0 km total 202 km
