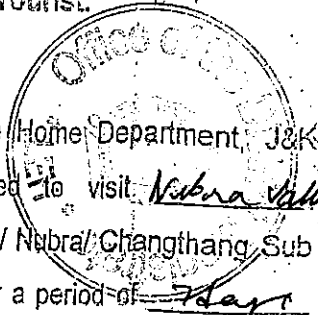

Following conditions should be observed strictly by the visitors:-

- That the permit holder will keep sufficient numbers of photo stat copies of the permit with them which may be required for depositing at each points of entry/exit.
- i. That the permit holder should not stay in the restricted/protected areas after expiry of permit.
- ii. That the permit holder will not take photograph of any sensitive places/defence installation areas in the restricted/ protected areas.
- iii. That the State Government Permit Issuing Authority will not be responsible for mishap to any permit holder in the restricted/protected areas.
- iv. The Protected Area Permit is issued free of cost from this office except Rs. 10/- (Rupees ten only) which will per charged per tourist as contribution towards red cross fund against receipt.
